Some Pastoral Thought on the Referendum on Marriage May 2015. "As I make my Confirmation visits these days, many priests and people ask for some guidance or direction in relation to the

upcoming referendum. I know this referendum on marriage is a complex and sensitive topic.

Therefore I feel that, as your bishop, I cannot in good conscience neglect to address this issue; I pray my words will in no way offend or hurt anyone. That is certainly not my intention....In making your referendum decision, I encourage you to value the model of Christian marriage which is the fundamental building block of our society."
