CCDA REPORT

Colm Bergin contacted re: extending lights out Birr Road, hoping funding be available next year. Gutters in Heritage Centre were cleared, and ivy

was removed from kitchen roof. Cost €450. Heritage Centre toilet doors and kitchen door was cleaned and painted. Presses were also cleaned. Trees on The Green were pruned. Flooding at Astra Pitch was drained at a cost of €1135. Electric costs in centre have dropped since solar panels installed but it will take a full year to really work out the savings. Bus shelter will soon be erected. Two new strips of wiring for Main Street to be purchased for Christmas lights. Dog fouling still a problem on soccer pitch. Look at higher mesh for balcony in Community Centre and more benches for players. We got €585 grant for energy bills. Next meeting January 24.
